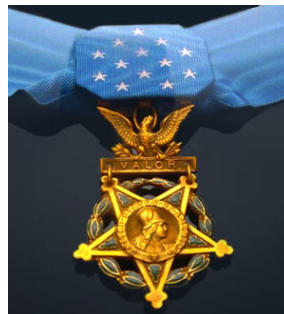

Ed Ridgley was Kemper's 17th and last President. Ridgley attended Kemper from 1960 to 1966 rising to the rank of cadet Colonel as the Corps Commander. Today he and his wife Martha live in the San Antonio, Texas area.
